 4. Pharaoh's daughter found Moses by me.
- (bulrushes, rushes, or papyrus)

1. I stood between Israel and the Egyptians.
 2. I was darkness to the Egyptians but light to the Israelites.
 3. My final position was to stand over the tabernacle.
 4. At night I was a pillar of fire.
- (cloud)

 3. God Himself wrote me.
 4. Many of my sentences begin with "Thou shalt not."
- (the Ten Commandments)
