We were brothers in the tribe of Levi. 2. We were priests, two older sons of Aaron. 3. We thought we could add to God's worship instructions. 4. When we offered “strange fire” in our censers, fire came from God and slew us. <p>(Nadab and Abihu)</p>

We served in Pharaoh's court. 2. We imitated Moses' and Aaron's signs. 3. Our snakes got swallowed up by Moses' snake. 4. When Israel arrived here, they had no water to drink. 2. Moses struck a rock, and water poured out. 3. Also, in my area, the Amalekites attacked the feeble Israelites. 4. (Broke the stone tablets with the Ten Commandments.) 	<p style="text-align: center;">What Part of the Tabernacle Am I? 12.19</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I am bronze and hold water. (laver) 2. I am bronze and hold sacrifices. (brazen altar) 3. We are made of curtains of goats’ hair, tanned rams’ skins, goatskins. (coverings) 4. I am made of blue and purple and scarlet yarns and fine twined linen with cherubim embroidered in me. (veil)

<p style="text-align: center;">What Part of the Tabernacle Am I? 12.19</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I am made of gold and have a gold mercy seat with cherubim. (ark of the covenant) 2. I am made of pure gold and have bowls that contain burning oil. (lampstand) 3. I am a place where incense is burned. (altar of incense) 4. I hold bread. (table of shewbread) 	<p style="text-align: center;">What Area of the Tabernacle Am I? 12.19</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I held the ark of the covenant. (Holy of Holies) 2. I was accessible to the priests and contained the table of shewbread, altar of incense, and lampstand. (Holy Place) 3. I was accessible to all the Israelites for sacrifices. (court yard) 4. Only the high priest could come into me once a year. (Holy of Holies)
<p style="text-align: center;">What Am I? 12.27</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I am a disease. 2. Miriam had me because she complained about Moses. 3. While she healed for seven days, Israel did not travel. 4. Moses prayed for Miriam, and God healed her. <p style="text-align: center;">(leprosy)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Who Are We? 12.28</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We are twelve men, one from each tribe of Israel. 2. We went into Canaan and found it to be a land flowing with milk and honey. 3. We also saw giants and walled cities. 4. Two of us believed God would give the land; ten did not believe. <p style="text-align: center;">(the twelve spies)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">What Am I? 12.29</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I became a sign to Israel when Korah, Dathan and Abiram rebelled against Moses & Aaron. 2. In this rebellion 250 men died and the earth opened to swallow the rebels. 3. Each tribe was to bring one like me to the tabernacle. 4. I sprouted, budded, blossomed, and bore almonds. <p style="text-align: center;">(Aaron's rod)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Who Am I? 12.30</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At an earlier event, God had told me to strike a rock, and water had flowed. 2. When Israel had no water again, God told me to speak to the rock at Horeb. 3. I was angry with Israel and shouted, "Must we fetch water from this rock, you rebels?" 4. When Moses prayed, He told him to make me. 3. Moses put me up on a pole so that people seeing me might be healed of snake bite. 4. Jesus said, "As Moses lifted up [me], so Jesus would be lifted up." <p>(bronze serpent)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Who Are We? 12.34</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We are two kings. 2. We controlled all the land east of the Jordan River. 3. Israel defeated us. 4. One of us was a giant whose bed was 13½ feet long. <p>(Sihon and Og)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Who Am I? 12.35</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Balak, king of Moab, sent for me to curse Israel. 2. My donkey let me know I shouldn't have gone by talking to me. 3. Every time I tried to curse, God made me speak blessing on Israel. 4. Eventually, I caused a curse by convincing Moab to intermarry with Israel. <p>(Balaam)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Where Did We Live? 12.37</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We are the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and one-half Manasseh. 2. We liked the area where we eventually lived. 3. Sihon and Og had been kings in this area. 4. All the other tribes settled on the other side of the Jordan. <p>(east of Jordan)</p>

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
