Who Am I? (13)

1. At least 4 times God told me to be strong and very courageous.
2. God promised to be with me just as He had been with Moses.
3. I led the Israelites into Canaan.
4. Before I died at 110 years, I warned Israel to serve the Lord, not false gods.

(Joshua)

Who Am I? (13)

1. I am a woman of Jericho.
2. I hid two Israelite spies.
3. They saved me and my family when Israel destroyed Jericho.
4. My grandson was Boaz, Ruth's husband.

(Rahab)

What Am I? (13)

1. I am a grain, but my stems are also useful.
2. Rahab had some of me drying on her roof.
3. Rahab hid two spies under me.
4. I can be made into linen cloth.

(flax)

What Am I? (13)

1. I am blue in color.
2. I flow from north to south between the Sea of Chinnereth (Galilee) and the Salt Sea.
3. Once my waters were held back several miles.
4. Twelve large stones are in my middle as a memorial of God's care for His people.

(Jordan River)

What Am I? (13)

1. I am located just west of the Jordan River near the Dead Sea.
2. I had two walls 30 feet tall and 6 feet thick.
3. Probably the oldest city in the world, I am 850 feet below sea level.
4. God conquered me with shouts and trumpets.

(Jericho)

What Am I? (13)

1. I am located near Jericho.
  2. Because I am small, Israel thought just a few men would be enough to conquer me.
  3. My inhabitants won a battle against Israel, killing about 36 men.
  4. After Achan's sin was corrected, Israel conquered me by ambush.
- (Ai)

Who Am I? (1)

1. I was a soldier at the Battle of Jericho.
  2. I took a garment, some gold, and some silver from Jericho.
  3. Because of my sin, Ai defeated Israel.
  4. My family and I lost our lives because of my sin.
- (Achan)

What Am I? (13)

1. Joshua built an altar to the Lord on me.
  2. Joshua wrote the Law on stones near me.
  3. Half of the Israelites stood on me.
  4. I am also called the Mount of Cursing.
- (Mount Ebal)

What Am I? (13)

1. As Joshua read the Law, half of the Israelites stood on me.
  2. Joshua proclaimed blessings and cursings before me.
  3. The tribes of Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Joseph, and Benjamin stood on me.
  4. I am the Mount of Blessing.
- (Mount Gerizim)

Who Are We? (13)

1. We live in the land of Canaan.
  2. We were afraid Israel would conquer our city.
  3. We pretended to come from a far country so that Joshua would make a covenant with us.
  4. Israel allowed us to live, but we became slaves.
- (Gibeonites)

What Am I? (13)

1. God did something miraculous with me during a battle to save the Gibeonites.
  2. First, God sent hailstones to slay the enemy.
  3. Then, Joshua told me to stand still.
  4. I didn't go down for about a day.
- (the sun)

Who Am I? (13)

1. I was one of the two oldest people to enter the Promised Land.
2. I told Joshua I was as strong as I had been 45 years before.
3. I wanted a particular land, but first I had to get rid of the giants that were there.
4. I had been a spy with Joshua.  
(Caleb)

What Are We? (13)

1. We were the only inheritance given to Levi.
2. There were 48 of us.
3. Half of us were west of Jordan; half were east.
4. A manslayer might flee to us so that he could be safe.  
(cities of refuge)

Who Are We? (13)

1. We decided to live on the east side of Jordan.
2. Joshua said we had to help the others conquer.
3. Our wives and children stayed east of Jordan.
4. When we returned home, we made a huge pile of stones to remind Israel that we were part of them.  
(Reuben, Gad, half tribe of Manasseh)

Who Am I? (13)

1. I was a son of Aaron.
2. I helped Joshua divide the land in Canaan.
3. I lived near the tabernacle at Shiloh.
4. I was high priest during Joshua's time.  
(Eleazar)

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
