

What Happened at Wells bulletin board

Well, Lots of Things Happened at Wells

- 1 Hagar saw God at Beerlahairoi ("I have seen God") when she was expecting Ishmael (Genesis 16).
- 2 When Hagar and Ishmael had left Abram and were dying of thirst, God showed them a well (Genesis 21).
- 3 Abraham dug a well and named it Beersheba ("well of the oath") when he made a covenant with Abimelech (Genesis 21).
- 4 Eliezer met Rebekah at the well of Haran (Genesis 24).
- 5 Rebekah came to Isaac near the well of Lahairoi (Genesis 24).
- 6 Isaac and Rebekah lived near the well Lahairoi (Genesis 25).
- 7 Wells Isaac dug—Esek ("arguing") and Sitnah ("hatred")—were taken by others (Genesis 26).
- 8 Wells at Rhenoboth ("room") and Shebah (Beersheba - "oath") showed God's blessing to Isaac in Canaan (Genesis 26).
- 9 Jacob met Rachel at the well outside Haran (Genesis 29).
- 10 Joseph's brothers cast him into a pit—a dry well (Genesis 37).
- 11 Moses met his future wife at a well in Midian (Exodus 2).

MIDDLE EAST MAP

Hagar saw God at **Beerlahairoi** (“I have seen God”) when she was expecting Ishmael (Genesis 16).
