

## Memory Verses, Questions and Answers

*Shortened portions for kindergarteners and first graders are underlined.*

- M1** Luke 10:27, 28 - "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; And, love your neighbor as yourself. . . Do this and you will live."
- M2** Exodus 20:1, 2 - And God spoke all these words: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery."
- Q1** How many commandments did God give on Mount Sinai? Ten commandments.
- Q2** What are the ten commandments sometimes called? The Decalogue.
- Q3** What do the first four commandments teach? Our duty to God.
- Q4** What do the last six commandments teach? Our duty to our fellow men.
- Q5** What is the sum of the ten commandments? To love God with all my heart, and my neighbor as myself.
- Q6** Who is your neighbor? All my fellow men are my neighbors.
- Q7** Is God pleased with those who love and obey him? Yes; He says, "I love them that love me."
- Q8** Is God displeased with those who do not love and obey him? Yes; "God is angry with the wicked every day."
- Q9** What is the first commandment? The first commandment is, **M3** You shall have no other gods before me.
- Q10** What does the first commandment teach us? To worship God alone.
- Q11** What is the second commandment? The second commandment is, **M4** "You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. **M5** You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, **M6** but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments."
- Q12** What does the second commandment teach us? To worship God in a proper manner, and to avoid idolatry.
- Q13** What is the third commandment? The third commandment is, **M7** You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses His name.
- Q14** What does the third commandment teach us? To reverence God's name, word, and works.
- Q15** What is the fourth commandment? The fourth commandment is, **M8** Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. **M9** Six days you shall labor and do all your work, **M10** but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the

Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates. **M11** For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but He rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

- Q16** What does the fourth commandment teach? To keep the Sabbath holy.
- Q17** What day of the week is the Christian Sabbath? The first day of the week, called the Lord's day.
- Q18** Why is it called the Lord's day? Because on that day Christ rose from the dead.
- Q19** How should the Sabbath be spent? In prayer and praise, in hearing and reading God's Word, and in doing good to our fellow men.
- Q20** What is the fifth commandment? The fifth commandment is, **M12** Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.
- Q21** What does the fifth commandment teach us? To love and obey our parents and teachers.
- Q22** What is the sixth commandment? The sixth commandment is, **M13** "You shall not murder."
- Q23** What does the sixth commandment teach us? To avoid angry passions.
- Q24** What is the seventh commandment? The seventh commandment is, **M14** "You shall not commit adultery."
- Q25** What does the seventh commandment teach us? To be pure in heart, language, and conduct.
- Q26** What is the eighth commandment? The eighth commandment is, **M15** "You shall not steal."
- Q27** What does the eighth commandment teach us? To be honest and industrious.
- Q28** What is the ninth commandment? The ninth commandment is, **M16** "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor."
- Q29** What does the ninth commandment teach us? To tell the truth.
- Q30** What is the tenth commandment? The tenth commandment is, **M17** You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.
- Q31** What does the tenth commandment teach us? To be content with our lot.
- Q32** Can any man keep these ten commandments perfectly? No mere man, since the fall of Adam, ever did or can keep the ten commandments perfectly.
- Q33** Of what use are the ten commandments to us? They teach us our duty, and show our need of a Savior.
